

A Resolution to Amend the BYLAWS REPUBLICAN PARTY OF BEXAR COUNTY as Adopted September 14, 2020

WHEREAS Article IV, Section 1, A, 5. , c. of the current Bylaws does not anticipate fully the County Executive Committee's importance and historical involvement in approval of actions that exceed limitations regarding contracts in excess of \$5,000 and has assigned this approval to the Budget Committee; and

WHEREAS the Budget Committee currently does not have at least five (5)... members and might not have five (5) members at the time a federal campaign relationship is requested as required by the current Bylaws, and

WHEREAS the Budget Committee may not be aware of certain campaign positions and issues, and

WHEREAS it is important that any contract that exceeds \$5,000 should be fully vetted and approved by the Executive Committee, and

WHEREAS the importance of federal campaign relationships is recognized; and

WHEREAS the Republican Party of Bexar County is committed to open and clarity of business and political practices, and

WHEREAS the Republican Party of Bexar County is committed to the Grass Roots principles.

THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED that the Bylaws of the Republican Party of Bexar County **Article IV, Section 1, A, 5. , c.** be amended to read as follows in the underlined wording:

A. County Chair: The duties and powers of the County Chair shall include, but not be limited to:

1. Presiding at all meetings of the County Executive Committee
2. Overseeing the County Republican Primary and Primary Runoff elections [TEC Chap. 172];
3. Being the official spokesperson and representative for the Executive Committee;
4. Employing staff personnel pursuant to workload requirements and budgetary allowances; and be responsible for the supervision and management necessary to maintain a well ordered County Headquarters;
5. Executing contracts:
 - a. With outside vendors up to \$5,000 and cannot extend beyond six (6) months after the County Chair's term of office;
 - b. That fall within the limitations set by the approved Executive Committee budget; and
 - c. In a working relationship with a federal campaign after consultation with the Executive Committee at a statutory meeting providing full details and copy of contract and receives approval from the Executive Committee by a simple majority.
