

OVER 65? NEED A MAIL-IN BALLOT? YOU MUST READ THIS

When any government makes a change, there is often good news and bad news.

That adage applies to the new Texas Election Integrity law which went into effect on December 2, 2021* which has added several

complications to the mail ballot application process this year.



First, the good news, the tag line for this law was: "easy to vote and hard to cheat." In order to get to the "hard to cheat" part, there are some challenges along the way.

The first is to ensure that all registered voters have two documents on file at their county elections office: either their state-issued driver's license number or personal ID number AND the last four digits of their social security number.
