



Ballot By Mail Application

If you are 65 or older on Election Day or you are disabled, you may submit an ANNUAL Ballot By Mail application

- Request a ballot to be mailed to you HERE
- The fillable form is also at <u>Bexar County Elections</u> <u>HERE</u>
- To prevent voter fraud, you must now provide a drivers' license number or the last four of your SSN to match with the number on the voter file. Unless you are sure which is on file, we recommend you submit both.



Upon completing and signing the form, return it to 1103 S Frio, Suite 100, San Antonio TX 78207. You can also call 210-335-VOTE (8683) to have an application for ballot by mail sent to you. **DEADLINE:** All Applications for Ballot by Mail must be received by the Bexar County Elections Department by 5 PM on February 18.
