JOINT FUNDRAISING NOTICE

Tony Gonzales Victory Fund ("**Fund**") is a joint fundraising committee established by the following committees: Tony Gonzales for Congress; Honor Courage Commitment PAC; Hispanic Leadership Trust; NRCC; and Results for Texas PAC.

Fund will allocate all receipts according to the following formula ("**Allocation Formula**"):

- (i) the first \$3,500 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the first \$5,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, will be allocated to Tony Gonzales for Congress's 2026 primary election account;
- (ii) the next \$3,500 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the next \$5,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, will be allocated to Tony Gonzales for Congress's 2026 general election account;
- (iii) the next \$5,000 of any contribution will be allocated to Honor Courage Commitment PAC;
- (iv) the next \$5,000 of any contribution will be allocated to Hispanic Leadership Trust;
- (v) the next \$44,300 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the next \$15,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, will be allocated to the NRCC;
- (vi) the next \$132,900 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the next \$45,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, will be allocated to the NRCC's Building Fund;
- (vii) the next \$132,900 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the remaining \$45,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, will be allocated to NRCC's Legal Proceedings Fund; and
- (ix) the remaining \$5,000 of any contribution will be allocated to Results for Texas PAC.

Notwithstanding the default Allocation Formula: (i) any donor may designate their contribution to a specific participating committee pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 102.17(c); (ii) if any portion of a contribution causes a contributor to exceed the contribution limit to one or more of the participating committees, then that portion of the contribution will be reallocated to the other participating committees to the fullest extent allowed by law; and (iii) if any portion of a contribution causes a contributor to exceed the contribution limit to all participating committees, or the contribution is not otherwise legally permissible, then that portion of the contribution will be refunded to the contributor.

Contributions are subject to the amount limits and source restrictions under federal law. The legal maximum that an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC may contribute to Fund in 2025 is \$332,100, whereas a federal multicandidate PAC may contribute \$130,000.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.

Texas law requires Results for Texas PAC to itemize information about individuals whose contributions exceed \$110 in a reporting period and use its best efforts to obtain and report the name, address, and principal occupation of individuals whose contributions exceed \$850 in a reporting period.

Contributions are not tax deductible. Contributions by corporations, foreign nationals, and federal government contractors are prohibited.
